On behalf of the Historic Wheels Club we should like to invite you to join in our 43rd Annual Rally Weekend. We are grateful to the main sponsors of our event, Glenfarclas Distillery, Walkers Shortbread and Speedy Asset Services.

On Sunday, 11th August 2019, by kind permission of the National Trust of Scotland, Rally entrants will assemble at Brodie Castle, near Forres. Following registration and refreshments, entrants will participate in a short road run through Moray. Those who have booked lunch will stop off at the Laichmoray Hotel in Elgin and back to Brodie Castle. **No vehicles will be allowed to enter the display area until they have registered and received a number.**

If you are not partaking of the run/lunch please feel free to remain parked at Brodie Castle for the static display which will be open to the public from 2.00pm. Please park up on your allotted numbered stance at Brodie Castle by 1.30pm. **No entry to the display field until 11.30pm**

As in previous years we expect a large variety of vehicles – we shall endeavour to accept all entries but some classes may become limited. If you wish your entry to be included in the event programme, please ensure your form is sent to the Rally Secretary to arrive no later than 20th July 2019. There are strictly no late entries after this date.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT BRODIE!**

***For an entry to be accepted, the Declaration AND GDPR consent on page 4 must be signed and accompanied by payment of the appropriate entry fee.***

### **Saturday, 10th August 2019**

#### ***Road Run & Visitor Attraction***

The Saturday Road Run is intended for those who wish to 'make a weekend' of the HWC Rally event. Entrants for the Road Run should meet from 10.30am for a 11.00am departure at the Old Station Car Park in Elgin; this car park is opposite the Laichmoray Hotel (IV30 1QR for those with Satnav) on Maisondieu Road.

The Run will leave Elgin for a scenic drive through Moray and surrounding areas to a local Visitor Attraction. Thereafter, entrants will continue to a venue for a High Tea at the end of the afternoon. The inclusive cost will be £20 per adult and £15 per child (12 years of age and under). In the past this event has proved very popular. In order to finalise meal bookings, and for the Club to take advantage of group discounts, please return your entry before 20th July if you wish to participate in the Saturday Run at the above prices.

***Later entries for the Run will be accepted but inclusive prices above cannot be guaranteed after 26th July.***

### **Sunday, 11th August 2019**

#### ***HWC Rally at Brodie Castle***

All entrants for the Rally should aim to arrive at Brodie Castle from 9.00am, but no later than 10.30am. On arrival, entrants will be invited to park up, then go to the Registration Team for their entry papers, rally information and 'goodie bags'. After registration, entrants will be able to take refreshments. Road Run departures will commence around 10.45am – older vehicles will leave first. However, the aim is for entrants to arrive at the Laichmoray Hotel in Elgin no later than 12.00pm, where lunches will be served to those who have booked them.

After lunch, entrants will depart Elgin for Brodie Castle (approximately 15 miles). The aim is for all entrants to be parked up in the Display Area at Brodie by 1.30pm. From 2.00pm the Display Area will be open to the public. The Rally awards will be presented from 4.00pm – the Club would request that vehicles do not leave the Display Area until this presentation is completed.

# Data Protection Policy:

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**Introduction:** This policy sets out how the Historic Wheels Club complies with GDPR legislation while achieving our objectives of the club.

**Data Collected:** We collect exhibitors' names, addresses, email addresses, and telephone numbers upon registering to attend our annual rally, and we update the information each time a change is advised by rally entrants. Entrants may also opt to provide the club with information in relation to the vehicles of exhibitors but this is not 'personal' information for the purposes of this policy.

**Data Controller:** The Club's Rally Secretary collects and maintains exhibitors' personal information in her/his capacity as Data Controller.

**Data Processors:** These are the secretaries of the club.

**Data Use:** We use data to send to each exhibitor notification of our annual rally and entry form by email or post.

**Data Storage and Retention:** The Data Controller holds current records in electronic format on a personal computer. All electronic files containing exhibitor data are password protected. In some cases, paper copies of entrant and car register forms are also retained. Records relating to the personal data of those who are no longer exhibitors are deleted from any electronic files after one year and paper copies destroyed after six years.

**What we DON'T do:**

- We do not give or sell personal data to any organisation, company or club.
- We do not pass exhibitors' personal details to any other individuals.
- We do not store exhibitors' bank, credit card and related financial information.
- We do not make multiple email addresses visible on webmail sent to exhibitors.
- We do not make exhibitors' details available on any websites or social media.

**Consent:** All current entrants have been informed of this policy. All future exhibitors will be asked upon registering a vehicle to attend the rally to acknowledge and sign that consent to hold the information has been given.

**Subject Access:** We will provide to any exhibitors' who asks the Club Secretary, the information held about him/her. However, as our committee members control what personal data is submitted to the Club this may be accessed and edited as when members so wish.

## Consent To Hold Personal Data

As you may know, the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) (Regulation (EU) 2016/679) came into force on 25 May 2018. This means that all UK organisations will need to demonstrate that they have 'opt-in' approval from persons whose personal data they hold. These regulations emanate from the EU and will not be affected by Brexit.

To comply with these regulations, we need all exhibitors' to consent so that the Club can use their data to send you rally entry forms.
